Meeting called to order at 6:33 PM.

Agenda reviewed. No adjustments.

CUD has decided to move forward with Fidium Fiber.

Discussed Belvidere Community Club request for financial support due to losses during pandemic. Andy Iwaskiewicz made a motion to engage the Belvidere Community Club Board of Directors to gain a further understanding of their financial shortcomings with the intentions to help cover losses during the period where Covid had an adverse effect on their revenue generations. Kathy Marchant seconds the motion. The motion passes unanimously.

Continued review of citizen suggestions. Discussed criteria that would assist in determining which suggestions would be most feasible. Reviewed which suggestions could be addressed through other funds such as grants. Many citizen suggestions centered around the Belvidere School House by the Morgan Bridge, Old School #2. Jack Slagle made a motion to clarify ownership of the property on which the Old School #2 sits and provides Kathy Marchant the authority to make contacts and pursue appropriate avenues to do so. Andy seconds motion. The motion passes unanimously. Kathy commits to pursue the ownership by contacting an attorney.
